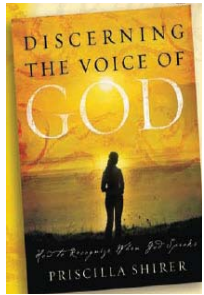

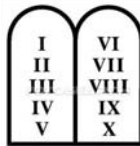


### *Basics of Fitness*

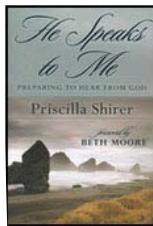


### *Old Commands for a Contemporary Faith*

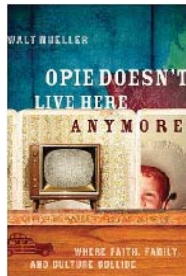

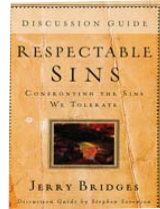
