There are many things that excite us in life. Some of us get excited at ball games or about an opportunity at work. Some of us have a passion for certain hobbies that get us excited as we anticipate participation in them. Sometimes we are even enthused at church. The word enthusiasm actually means "in God." ### **What is Contemplative Worship?**

In the midst of a culture of multiple responsibilities and exhausting schedules, many are seeking a place of quiet – a place where one be at rest, in worship, to experience the presence of God. (Psalm 46:10) They seek revitalization and harmony that only God's Spirit can give. In many Christian traditions, worship which is still, reflective and meditative is a common balance to our regular services of praise and preaching the Word of God.

Contemplative worship is a setting in which we quiet ourselves through inward Christian disciplines like silence, prayer, guided meditation, lectio divina, reflective listening to music and receiving communion. This is done in an attempt to open our souls to the ministry of God within. Through contemplative worship, we place ourselves vulnerably in the way of God's grace and wait for God to speak and touch.

One does not have to be proficient in a certain Christian discipline or skill to participate. Worshiping in this way simply implies a desire to seek God and to be open to however God's Spirit might choose to move within our lives. The aim is an intimacy of relationship rooted deeply in the love shared between Creator and creature.
