This coming Sunday we will continue our celebration of Advent with two special services. In the two morning services our Adult Choir, along with help from our Youth and Children Choirs, will present our annual Christmas Cantata. ADVENT for the FAMILY

Advent Calendars are available in the hallways for families to use and enhance their family worship during the Christmas Season.

Make Christmas Memories

Make jam, cookies, candy, or sweets together. Or select some nice ones at the store. Decorate a plate or plastic container. Place sweets in container. Decide who to take the treats to and visit together as a family.

Read Christmas books. Collect some favorite Christmas books or stories. Find an evening to sit together as a family and read books. Allow all ages to read or tell a favorite story. Preschool children can tell stories while older children might read.

Trim your tree together. Make decorating your house a family event. If this is too chaotic, then choose a room or just the tree to decorate as a family. Make ornaments or share about the different ones on the tree.

Make a homemade spice gift. Put cloves, cinnamon sticks, grated nutmeg, and allspice into cheesecloth squares. Tie with fabric strips. Pack in a small gift bag with a box of tea. Pack basil, marjoram, thyme, and rosemary with olive oil and tomato sauce for an Italian twist.

Go Caroling as a Family. Make an effort to go caroling in your neighborhood or to a nursing facility or hospital. Join in our church's caroling on December 20. Consider taking along Christmas ornaments, decorations, or fruit to give away.

Act out the Christmas Story. Bring out the bathrobes, towels and pieces of cloth. Find a baby doll and a box. Allow children to dress in costumes representing the characters of the story found in Luke 2. As one person reads the Bible passage, encourage family members to act out certain parts or scenes. Take a picture. You will make a memory that lasts a lifetime.

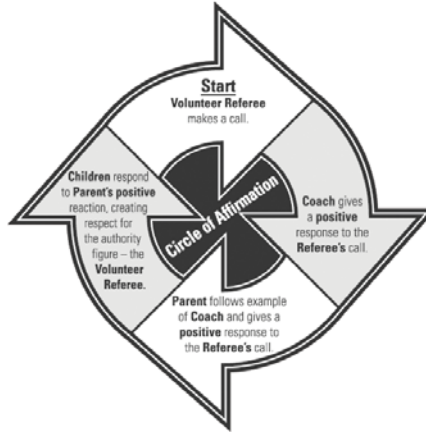
