



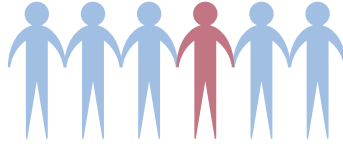

Did You Know?

Did you know that Trinity has 35 standing committees, to assist in getting out God's message of love and salvation? Baptism, Missions Steering, Building and Grounds and Benevolence are some of the committees, just to name a few. Trinity members are nominated by the Committee on Committees and then elected in church conference to serve. Their work is the backbone of getting the mission of TBC done. Their support for the Ministerial staff and congregation is very important.

The Benevolence Committee responds to requests for emergency assistance from Trinity members and those attending Trinity, as well as immediate family members or friends of members. Benevolence funds have been used to pay rent, utilities, mortgage

or other essential services. This assistance has been for families or individuals, who have lost their jobs, experienced a medical emergency, or other unexpected crises. Funds are not available to cover long term shortfalls, but can help with transitional needs and serve to remind folks that their Christian brothers and sisters care for them. It has been a difficult time for those on fixed income, those who have lost their jobs and others who have been impacted by the current and protracted economic situation. The Benevolence Committee may be able to help. Funds are provided through the church budget and from offerings designated for this purpose. New "Jobs For Life" Class

To Start at TBC on September 12



Jobs for Life is an outreach mission designed for persons or who are currently unemployed, or who are employed, but desire to have a better job. Students make an 8 week, 32 hour investment to make their employment future more promising.

TBC will be hosting a new JfL class on Sunday and Wednesday evenings, beginning Sunday, September 12. This eight week course consists of 16 two hour sessions, combining instruction in principles which build character and in job readiness / job search skills. In addition, each student will be matched with a team of "champions" - their own coaching team to help them succeed through the course as well as new employment. And Graduates will have first priority access to

While taking a few days off, I had the chance to read a book that was given to me as a graduation gift. It's entitled (*Will Jesus Buy Me a Double-Wide? -Cause I Need More Room For My Plasma TV*) by Karen Spears Zacharias. The book's focus is to combat the ever-growing prosperity gospel that is being taught by so many of the high profile preachers in our culture.

Prosperity gospel refers to the belief that our financial means are some how tied to our faithfulness to God. It is the idea that the more we love Jesus and serve him, the more wealth we are going to accumulate. Zacharias writes, "We teach our children that we have earned God's good favor and that's why we're so rich, so healthy, so pretty, so smart, and so free to do as we doggone please." Many preachers have filled pulpits with the theology of we receive what we deserve. I don't know about you, but I am glad that this is not the case.

The way I understand the Scripture is that we do not receive what we deserve because of the love of Christ. We deserve death and eternity in Hell, but we receive grace and the Kingdom of Heaven if we believe in the death and resurrection of Jesus. Because of the indescribable love of Christ, we have an opportunity to have an abundant life full of love, peace and joy.

Jesus taught about money and greed frequently in the Bible. I think Jesus understood our sinful nature of always wanting more. Our greed gets in the way of receiving the true blessings Jesus desires for us to have. Having money certainly doesn't make us greedy nor unchristian. It just makes us more responsible for how we use it to glorify God and to build up his Kingdom here on earth! Zacharias' book reminded me of how I should live!

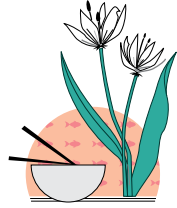
