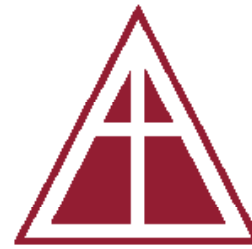

Proposed Bylaw Changes

Article VIII • Meetings of Members
 Section 1. ~~Worship Services. The regular worship services of the church shall be held every Sunday morning and Sunday evening and every Wednesday evening for the worship of Almighty God., unless otherwise agreed upon by the church. Prayer, praise, preaching, instruction, and evangelism shall be among the ingredients of these services. The senior pastor shall direct the services for all the church members and for all others who may choose to attend. oversee direction of all services for members and others who may attend. Sunday evening and Wednesday evening worship services, programs, and ministries will be planned and coordinated through the work of the Church Council. The annual church calendar will be presented to the monthly business meeting in January.~~

Article VIII • Meetings of Members
 Section 3. Regular and Annual Business Meetings. The church shall hold regular business meetings monthly on the third Sunday night of the month, unless otherwise designated by the Church Council and presented at a business meeting. The January business meeting shall be the annual meeting of the members.

Article V • Other Leadership Positions
 Section 3. Church Council. (b) The Church Council, chaired by the senior-pastor's designated designee church minister member of on the ministerial staff of the church, shall meet periodically with the church ministerial staff to plan and to coordinate the activities and functions of the various organizations of the church. church ministries. The Church Council will coordinate the overall church calendar in regards to worship services, programs, and ministries. The annual church calendar will be presented to the monthly business meeting in January.

Thoughts for Parents...

How Not to Lose Your Cool When Your Child Already Has!

Parenting a toddler can be tough work on the best day. When things aren't going well and your preschooler is downright cranky, it can seem impossible to show godly love and patience to this little person who is pushing all your buttons.

The way we react to everyday situations, however, helps our children understand what is OK and what is not. It is how we react to life's more challenging moments that is crucial. One of the most challenging of early childhood events is the temper tantrum.

Understanding some common causes for tantrums can help prevent them. Ask yourself whether one or more of these could be the cause or trigger of your preschooler's meltdown.

Hunger: Even grownups get a little cranky when they are hungry. Children are no different; so try to maintain a regular eating schedule. Pack healthy snacks for those occasions when you cannot eat at a normal mealtime.

Fatigue: A tired toddler equals a miserable parent. Sticking with naptime routines can help ward off tantrums. Readjust your expectations of how much you can squeeze into one day of shopping or a week at a theme park. Finding time to let your preschooler rest will pay off in the long run.

Attention: Sometimes toddlers throw tantrums to get attention from their favorite audience: mother and daddy. If you find that your preschooler is prone to lose her cool and you can't attribute it to hunger or lack of rest, try to determine if she may be looking for some one-on-one attention from you. Make time to look at a book, snuggle a bit, or play together.

Frustration: Preschoolers are often frustrated when they cannot do certain things or do not have a choice about things that matter to them. Where possible, allow your preschooler the freedom to make simple choices (such as "would you like to wear the red shirt or the blue shirt?"). Make sure toys are age-appropriate, and keep breakable or "off-limits" items out of reach to avoid using the "no" word too frequently.

Above all, remember that toddler tantrums are normal and common. Even mild-mannered preschoolers will have the occasional moment of glory screaming at the top of their lungs or holding their breath until they turn blue. So, take a deep breath, try to relax, and remember that you are not alone!!
