

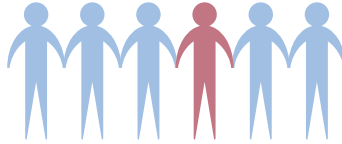

As many of you have heard, our Student Ministry Intern Jenny Lee has been called to be the new Minister to Youth at First Baptist Church in Asheville, North Carolina. I am delighted for Jenny to have such a great opportunity to begin her full time ministry. Jenny has been a wonderful part of our ministry team for her nearly three years and everyone who has spent time with Jenny is aware of her many gifts, abilities, spiritual maturity and devotion to ministry. We will miss Jenny, but we are excited for her. It is a true compliment to Jenny and to Rev. Jung and our Student Ministry for a congregation like First Baptist to consider and call our Student Ministry Intern. It is an indication of how well our internship program has worked and also the strength of our student ministry. I hope you will take the time to tell Jenny you will be praying for her and to thank her for her time and ministry with us.

In our March Church Conference the church voted to approve a recommendation by our Personnel Committee to establish a Student Ministry Associate Position. This is a 30 hour a week position and will focus on our ministry to Middle School students and their families as well as assisting Rev. Jung with the whole Student Ministry. Rev. Jung will serve as the immediate supervisor of this position. Unlike our Internship Program this position will follow the process of calling a minister to Trinity in accordance with our By-Laws. A search committee has been established by our Personnel Committee consisting of Student Ministry Advisory Committee members and Personnel Committee members. They have advertised the position and are in the process of receiving resumes. Please be in prayer for this committee and their work. The committee will keep the church informed of its progress.

We are truly a blessed congregation to have the opportunity to pass on our faith to the next generation. This is a sacred task which should concern all of us and requires our interest and prayers. Continue to pray for our students and how we can best encourage them in faith.

Trinity is partnering with Lagoon Road Baptist Church in Central Belize, a new English speaking church with around 90 in attendance. When we met them in early 2009, the church was meeting in one large room – their sanctuary, a small room for children, and a thatched outdoor shelter for youth. After two mission trips, Trinity has assisted the church in building four nice Sunday School rooms and two restrooms.

The next step in our partnership is to do a Vacation Bible School for 150 children, a part of which will be a dental clinic for all the children involved. In the evenings, we will host revival services at the church with Dr. Roberts preaching, and a TBC “choir” to provide special music. Obviously we need a large team of 30 adults over age 18 to do this mission well.

Cost for the trip (assuming air fares do not increase dramatically) will be around \$1,200 per person including air and ground transportation, lodging, food, and insurance. You will need a current passport and several vaccinations.

## Sharing and Taking Turns



Good behavior depends on a sense of responsibility, which evolves as your preschooler recognizes that there's more to life than immediate gratification of his needs. Assuming responsibility for his/her actions is a basic social requirement. He/she needs to understand that aggressive behavior such as hitting, kicking and pushing aren't acceptable ways of dealing with frustration. To get along with others he/she must cooperate by sharing and taking turns.

Your unconditional love makes your preschooler feel worthy, which contributes to his/her self-esteem, a vital prerequisite for good behavior, as well as getting along with others. If he/she feels good about themselves, they will be motivated to behave well. Without a positive self image and reputation to live up to, he has little incentive.
