

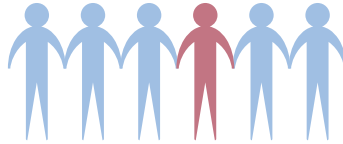

This presentation will help raise funds for our high school youth to travel to Perry County, Alabama to work with some of the poorest families in the United States. The day will be filled with over 200 Trinity members going out into the community to perform mission projects all over Wake County. This fall and spring event is a great way for everyone of every age at Trinity to get their "hands dirty" doing missions. If your class has signed up for a project please plan to attend and be a part of this church wide mission effort.

If you miss these mission opportunities then plan to be part of the ROC "N" Golf Tournament on May 14th at River Ridge Golf Club. This annual event is open to Trinity members and non-members. This fund helps us provide scholarships for Trinity members not only on Trinity mission trips but students who go on mission with various organizations. All of the proceeds of the ROC "N" Golf Tournament support this fund. Without the Shaw Mission Fund we cannot continue to create the opportunity for missions at Trinity that we currently enjoy. Plan to play or support this mission effort.

Trinity is partnering with Lagoon Road Baptist Church in Central Belize, a new English speaking church with around 90 in attendance. When we met them in early 2009, the church was meeting in one large room – their sanctuary, a small room for children, and a thatched outdoor shelter for youth. After two mission trips, Trinity has assisted the church in building four nice Sunday School rooms and two restrooms.

The next step in our partnership is to do a Vacation Bible School for 150 children, a part of which will be a dental clinic for all the children involved. In the evenings, we will host revival services at the church with Dr. Roberts preaching, and a TBC “choir” to provide special music. Obviously we need a large team of 30 adults over age 18 to do this mission well.

Cost for the trip (assuming air fares do not increase dramatically) will be around \$1,200 per person including air and ground transportation, lodging, food, and insurance. You will need a current passport and several vaccinations.

Why Peru? This is the question I have been asked many times since the announcement was made regarding the HS summer mission trip for 2011. While it does seem somewhat random, it has been a prayerful decision.

In planning the 2007 mission trip to Puerto Rico, the Student Ministry decided that our high school students would have an opportunity for a foreign mission experience every four years. Thus, I knew that 2011 mission trip was looming ahead and plans needed to be made 18 months in advance. I began looking for possible mission organizations to partner with. I made contacts, researched ministries and prayerfully considered where our students could make an impact while experiencing a new culture.

Last November, while at the National Youth Workers Convention, I met Erin and Pepe Acat. They lead a ministry called Frontline Peru, helping to bring people to Peru to work with some of the outer villages near major cities. Something about the couple caught my attention as I was perusing through hundreds of booths in the convention center. Their eagerness, excitement and humbleness helped me to feel at ease. They were organized, answered all of my questions with

specifics and gained my confidence in their ability to host a large group. Throughout the decision making process, I always kept the safety of students in the forefront and the feasibility of the cost. It wasn't long after I met Erin and Pepe that I knew Peru is where God was leading our ministry.

I know that the \$1,200 price tag is daunting to most families. That is the very reason why we have started the process so early. In addition, the SMAC has set a goal of \$35,000 to raise in the next 12 months to help defray the cost per person even further. If we achieve the goal, it is possible that each person's cost can be reduced to as low as \$700. I know that it seems like an impossible task to raise that kind of money but I really believe that it is possible through our church family. I am in the process of putting together a Fundraising Team to brainstorm and put plans in place to make it a possibility.

I pray that if you currently have 8th-11th grade student, you would consider your student being a part of this "once-in-a-lifetime" mission experience. Please do not let money get in the way of this discipleship opportunity for your student. As with all other trips, scholarships are available.
