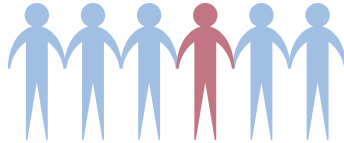

In a time when Baptists in North Carolina needed options for ministry education, Campbell University birthed the Campbell University Divinity School. This school has already had an impact on our congregation. Not only do we have two graduates from Campbell Divinity School on our ministerial staff, but we have found the school to be a great resource for future ministers and interns. In addition, many on our staff continue their relationship with the school through serving on boards or teaching at the school. This coming Sunday, we will be observing our annual Baptist Heritage Day. This day is a day to remember those who have paved the way for many of us in regards to our church and the broader Baptist experience. During our morning service we will recognize an individual who has had a significant impact on either our congregation or Baptist life. This coming Sunday we will be honoring Dr. Michael Cogdill. Dr. Cogdill is the founding Dean of the Campbell University Divinity School. Dr. Cogdill has announced his resignation as Dean and intention to return to the faculty of the school and continue his teaching of young and developing ministers. In conjunction with this transition in his life, we believe that honoring him for his work not only at the school, but the impact his leadership has had on our church and churches all over North Carolina is fitting and over due. We will be presenting the Trinity Baptist Church Baptist Heritage Award to Dr. Cogdill as part of our Baptist Heritage celebration this Sunday in worship. I hope that you will join us for worship and as we celebrate God's faithfulness in the past and promise for our future. Baptist Heritage Day is not only about the past, but our future. It is a day that we remember that the work God began God will bring to completion. I look forward to being with you in worship this coming Sunday.

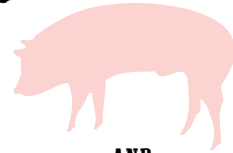

On a sad note, I want to say a word about our departed friend, James Myers, who died last Thursday evening after a long bout with aggressive cancer. Many of you may not know this, but James was the first Disaster Relief Coordinator for Trinity. He sensed God's calling to discover what D.R. was all about. He was one of the first to get certified by NC Baptist Men and Red Cross.

He was also the “mover and shaker” behind purchasing and outfitting our first D.R. trailer. Little did any of us know that God was using James to prepare Trinity for responding to the devastation after Hurricane Katrina. Thankfully, we were able to get our “feet wet” on several smaller call outs before the “big one”. But once called, James was on the first team to respond to the Gulf Coast disaster and went on several more trips over the two years we sent teams every other month. I know James was active in many other ministries in our church – including the Instrumental Ensemble. But I thank God I was able to serve alongside him as God enabled his dream of Disaster Relief Ministry at TBC to become a reality.

Louis Pearce has picked up the mantle as Coordinator for the D.R. Ministry. He and a Lead Team of persons committed to being ready to go and serve people in desperate situations will carry on wonderfully. But none of us will ever forget the one who set the stage for the development of the D.R. Ministry at TBC for many years to come. Thanks, James. We'll miss you.

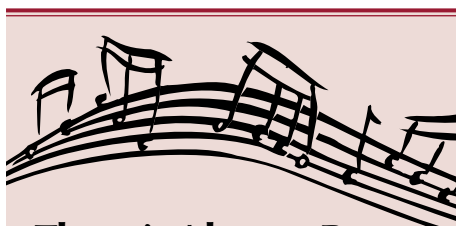

Summer is quickly approaching and plans are being made for the High School Summer Mission Tour to Perry County, Alabama. Final contacts are being made and details are coming together.

This past week, I had the daunting task of choosing the construction projects from a list sent by the CBF missionaries in Perry County. There were 41 projects on the list and I needed to pick out 2-3 projects for our group. I must admit this was a difficult task. I was deeply moved by the great need I saw on paper. Project after project, I read about roofs needing replaced, floors needing repaired, homes needing to be painted and much more. I read through all 41 on the list and was overwhelmed by the enormity of the need in the area.

Through the leading of the Holy Spirit, I was led to two HUGE projects that will challenge our crew this summer. The one that especially touched my heart was Ms. Lucy's home. She is a widow of 5 years and lives at home with her son and daughter. When

her husband passed away, they had to take out a second mortgage on the home to pay for the funeral expenses. Her son, Johnny, has medical conditions that require him to receive dialysis three times a week. They live in an old farm house that Ms. Lucy had purchased from a former employer and both Ms. Lucy and her daughter work as cooks at a local restaurant. Due to leaky pipes, Ms. Lucy has had to disconnect the water to her home. She drives to nearby Sprott Springs for water to use at home. Our team will do everything possible to reconnect her home with water without leaks. In addition, the home is in great need of repair. It needs a new roof, floors replaced and ceilings repaired. This project will challenge our skills and resolve but I know we will accomplish as much as possible.

I am reminded of the need we have all around us in our community, nation and the world. May we continue to build up the Kingdom of God here on earth as we serve Christ daily.

## Television and Your Child



Have you ever wondered how much television is too much for your child?

Facts about television viewing:

- When children are watching television, he/she is not focused on playing.
- Children's view of right and wrong will be influenced by what they see on television.
- Children formulate language by interacting with people who talk and read to them, not through language children hear on television. Children must hear actual words and language spoken by other persons around them.
- With every hour of television viewing, the risk of obesity increases.
- Over exposure to television viewing limits a child's imagination.
- Media does not help a child develop persistence.
- Many cartoons contain violence. Children and adults will become desensitized to violence when watching scenes of violence over and over.
- One hour per day is recommended for 2 to 5 year olds.
