McCreary County, KY Summer Mission Trip

July 16 - 23, 2011

Our mission partnership with McCreary Co, KY through the Rural Poverty Initiative of the CBF will continue this summer into its 5th year. We partner directly with Hills and Hollers Ministries' director Jim Cmolik to provide materials and labor for one or two homes desperately in need of repair. Through Jim, we also get to meet pastors and other non-profit coordinators who have needs that we can meet through various means such as VBS with children, working with abused women and their children, visiting with the "elderly" of the county, food pantries and clothing closets, etc. We want this partnership to attract both those who enjoy construction, and those who would rather do other things.

We stay at the "Mission House" in Whitley City operated by Jim that accommodates 30 adults in bunk beds with mattresses, with air conditioning, dining area, meeting area and a front porch swing. Our Trinity Cook Team, headed by Dorothy Petty feeds us home cooked meals. Just down the road is the "Dairy Bar" where the TBC team goes to literally "chill out" each evening.

If this sounds like a mission in which you would enjoy participating, please sign up NOW on the Registration Board in the Narthex. It will fill up fast, so don't wait! The non-construction portion of our trip will be announced around the first of March.

Thoughts For Parents...

Teaching Your Preschoolers to Pray

Preschoolers and Children can and will learn about prayer and how to pray if they have significant adults in their lives who are willing to teach them. In the Old Testament the child Samuel was a gift from God to a praying mother. As a result of this answered prayer, Samuel was taken to the temple to be taught by Eli the priest. God spoke to Samuel at a very young age and gave him a message to give to Eli, a man who had not always been obedient to the Lord. Eli said to Samuel, "What was the message He gave you? Don't hide it from me," Samuel gave God's message Eli, and Samuel grew and the Lord was with him. (1 Samuel 3:17-19) From this passage we see the value and importance God placed on one small boy.

How early can we teach preschoolers and children to pray?

When a child is born, there exists a potential for the child to have a relationship with his Creator. From birth the child develops physically, mentally, socially, emotionally, and spiritually. Significant adults need to nurture the spiritual development of



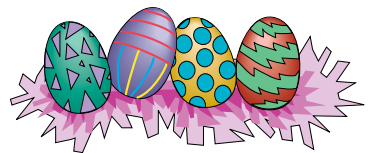
preschoolers by teaching them that prayer is a way to talk to God who created them.

We can teach the very young child about prayer by using appropriate language. In their presence we can thank God for their very lives, the provisions of life, the Bible as a gift to us from God, and the people placed in our families and church. "Thank You, God" should be the first prayer taught to the developing child. As the child grows, the prayers can be expanded to include more relationships and content. Older children can be introduced to more developmentally appropriate ways of learning about prayer and how to pray.
