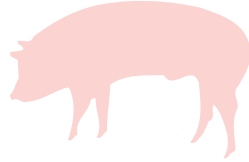

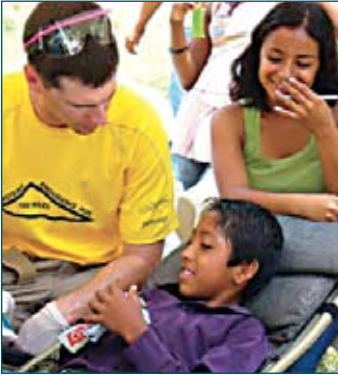

Medical Mission Belize



1,157 Patients Seen



What a week we had as our 18 person medical / dental / optometric team joined the members of Lagoon Road Baptist Church in St. Margaret's Village in Belize to host a 5 Day Clinic for the region in their church! God blessed our preparations with persons lined up at the church each morning reaching out for much needed treatments / medications from the volunteer medical doctors, dentists, dental hygienist, and optometrist. Most of these people cannot afford to get health care treatment and learn to live with pain and maladies. In addition, the healthcare system in Belize is located in the cities, not in rural

areas like St. Margaret's. But when those with the gifts of healing come to the area, they take advantage of it! To see the smiles on faces when they looked up for the first time with a pair of glasses that enabled them to see and read was moving. To watch as the dentists did their work and pain was relieved; or the hygienist cleaned adults' teeth that had not been brushed in their whole lives – was amazing. To see persons with diseases that are curable with simple antibiotics or anti-parasitical meds receive drugs that will relieve their conditions was so satisfying.

But there is so much more to do. Our Medical Missions team will begin work now to recruit a team and get back to Belize in the year ahead. If you are a medical professional of any kind, please consider contacting Hal Melton now to put your name on a list that will get emails as soon as dates are set for the next trip. We would love to double the size of the team next year!
