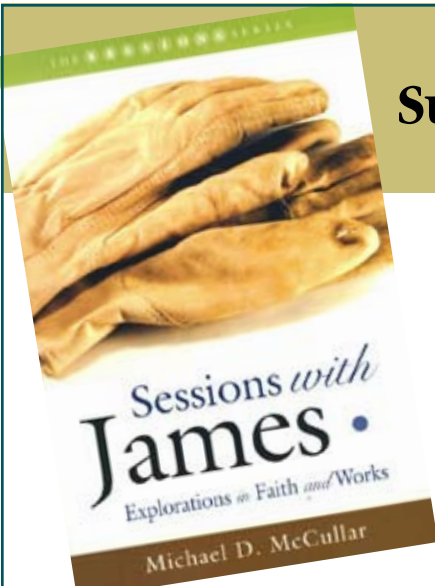

## How Your Child Can Help Around the House

### A 2-year old can:

- Take spoons from you and carry them over to the table.
- Carry napkins to the table.

### A 3-year old can:

- Fold napkins in half and put them at each family member's seat.
- Lay out place mats in their proper positions.

### A 4-year old can:

- Bring glasses and drinks to the table (just remind him to use two hands).
- Put dishes and utensils down at each place setting.

Being able to pitch-in with household work makes your preschooler feel competent, helping to build his sense of pride and responsibility.
