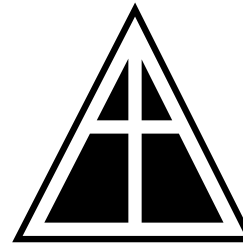

Thoughts For Parents...

Praying for Your Child

Do you remember the story of Hanna who was the childless wife of Elkanah? She longed to be a mother. She fervently asked God to answer her prayer. When God gives Hannah the desire of her heart, her prayers did not stop. First Samuel 2:1-10 records Hannah's praise to God for hearing and answering her prayers. Hannah knew what she wanted. She prayed persistently, specifically, and with great faith. Our prayers, including those for our children, should follow her example.

Be Persistent

Pray daily for your child. Set aside a certain time each day to spend with God. Guard this time zealously. Interruptions may occur, but remember that you are the person entrusted with caring and praying for this child!

Be Specific

Tell God exactly what you desire for your child. Lamentations 2:19 directs us to pour out our hearts like water before the Lord and to lift up our hands to Him for the lives of our children.



Be Faithful

Pray faithfully and expectantly. Hebrews 11:6 states that without faith it is impossible to please God and that to come to Him, we must believe that He exists and rewards those who seek Him.

Model prayer to your child. Teach your child that prayer can occur anytime, anywhere.

Schedule a daily family prayer time. Let your child know you are praying for him.

Hannah thanked God for her son, Samuel and gave him to the Lord for his service. Her specific, persistent, and faithful prayers met with great results. In 1 Samuel 2:26, we learn that Samuel grew physically, was blessed by God, and was well thought of by people. Hannah's prayers were answered. God will not fail to hear yours!

Words from Hal What a blessed week our KY Mission Team just spent with our growing group of friends in McCreary County! The Eagle Community Center was swarming with children and youth enjoying a VBS that our team prepared focusing on the 10 Commandments. On the other end of the county Greg and Stacy Vaughn and their three young boys gladly endured a week of construction noise and inconvenience to see the results of a new large bedroom for the boys, and a much needed new metal roof on their home.

Our Trinity team was challenged mightily by the heat on both projects, however, they persevered and God blessed their efforts. Transformation of heart and mind is a result of the KY Mission Trips. Poverty seen close up in our country results in a re-assessment of priorities, and also, as Neil Loyd pointed out to the Vaughn family as he presented a Bible to them on the last day, an appreciation of family closeness that they enjoy and rely on to survive. We'll be returning to KY next summer – let God move your heart to go and serve.

2012 Adult Overseas Missions Opportunities Belize & Kenya

In the coming year we will be expanding our mission efforts at home and abroad. Since overseas trips are expensive, we want to let you know NOW about opportunities for next year so that financial savings can add up over time enabling you to consider participating.

Belize School Construction January 26 - February 2

This will be a cooperative effort of several NC CBF churches to complete construction of a much needed school building in the village of St. Elena in western Belize. Cost (including air fare, ground transportation, lodging, meals, insurance and t-shirt) will be in the area of \$1,400.

A SECOND trip to work on this school construction will be later in the year. A date has not been set at this point and will depend on progress of the project with our Belizean Baptist friends.

Belize Medical Mission • May 11-19

We need Dentists, Doctors, Ophthalmologists, Optometrists, Nurses, Dental Assistants, and Dental Hygienists for this trip in addition to non-medical personnel for registration, sterilization, organization, and playing with children on site. Cost (including air fare, ground transportation, lodging, meals, insurance and t-shirt) will be in the area of \$1,400.

Kenya Church Planting Mission August 7-17

This mission is in cooperation with the Kenyan Baptist Association assisting in their efforts to begin Bible studies and eventually churches in villages without a Christian church. The strategy is to help build a simple sapling / mud house for a widow and children chosen by the village leaders. This new home is also the location for a new Bible study in the village taught by a Baptist missionary to the village. Out of the growth of the Bible study, a new church is chartered. We will build a new home in a different village four days in a row. We will have a LOT of opportunity to share the gospel in word and deed on this trip, do simple Bible stories with children / adults, pray over the sick of the village and see how God is working through this simple strategy to reach whole villages for Christ. Cost (including air fare, ground transportation, lodging, meals, insurance and overnight in a game reserve) will be in the area of \$2,300.

Lou Ann O'Bryant went on this trip with others from around NC last year and is so excited about leading a team from TBC. We can only take 8 on a team due to ground transportation restrictions – so if you would like to go, let Lou Ann or Hal know ASAP.
