This past Sunday evening, in Church Conference, our church voted to take the next step in regards to our Facilities Master Plan. Our Facilities Master Planning Committee made it's second presentation with a schematic plan for possible expansion of our narthex, sanctuary and additional education space. There were good questions and discussion, following the presentation. The committee recommended to the church that a financial assessment committee be formed to formulate a financial plan for the undertaking of such a project and to report this plan to the church. This plan will take into consideration our current debt, our resources, the timing of such a project and the financial resources that will be necessary to precede with any future expansion. The Trustees have been charged with forming this committee and will make their recommendation to the church in the September Church Conference. I am so pleased with our church's diligent and intentional steps toward our future together concerning not only our campus, but most importantly our ministry to our community and world. Thank you church for being a people of God who continue to dream and believe that God's best is always yet to be experienced.

I am looking forward to our final August Worship Celebration this coming Sunday. In our morning services, we will have the celebration of baptism and the Lord's Supper. In addition, our own Trinity Laymen will be our special worship guests. Then we complete our special August services with a concert at 6:00 p.m. in the Sanctuary featuring the Trinity Laymen and First Four from First Baptist Asheboro. The evening will conclude with homemade ice cream in the Fellowship Hall provided by Department 4. Join your church family for worship and fellowship this coming Sunday.

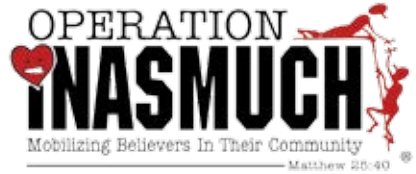
