# Taking the Next Step...

During our past Church Conference, our Personnel Chair David York reported to the church the work of the Personnel Committee and Senior Adult Ministry Committee in regards to the future of our Senior Adult Ministry. Our outstanding Senior Adult Coordinator, Dorothy Petty, indicated to us this past summer that she was not intending to continue in this position for the next year. Dorothy has done a tremendous job the past 10 years in this volunteer position. The ministry that she has helped build and the growing need of ministry to Senior Adults in our congregation, as well as the general population, caused us to take a look at the future of leadership in this area in our church. After several months of conversation and prayer, it was determined that it would be in the best interest of the church not to create a new paid position but to re-allocate the time of our ministerial staff to address this growing ministry need.

A sub-committee from Personnel and Senior Adults worked with me and Rev. Melton to design a new job description that would allow Rev. Melton to give more attention to our Senior Adult Ministry. Rev. Melton's new title will be Associate Pastor/Adult Missions and Senior Adult Ministries. Rev. Melton has been a part of this conversation from the beginning and is excited about this new ministry. This new job description creates more time for Rev. Melton to be personally involved with our Senior Adult Committee and ministries, as well as time for visitation with our seniors as needed. We have also asked Rev. Melton to work with our Senior Adult Committee to envision form and function of the committee to enable our ministry to seniors to grow and flourish.

Rev. Melton will continue to lead our Missions Ministry as well as assisting me in areas of Pastoral Care, Marriage Ministry, and will also continue to be the supervising minister in my absence.

The major area of ministry that Rev. Melton will no longer be directly giving leadership too will be in the area of Adult Education. This would include both Adult Sunday School and our Discipleship Program. I, along with our age group ministers, will take the lead with our Sunday School Council and our Discipleship Leadership to ensure that these ministries continue to grow. I will personally be the point person working with Adult Sunday School and Discipleship.

We are truly blessed at our church to have a talented group of ministers who not only bring certain expertise to their positions but gifts and a willingness to serve. This allows us to address needs in our church with a team approach. I firmly believe that we have the staff to cover our ministerial needs and ministry programs. As our ministers continue to work as a team and most importantly as we seek to enable church members to lead and serve, I believe we are ready to be used by God.

God continues to bless our church with a great future. I hope that you are connected and serving as we move into the future together.
